Q & A**

When is the Summer LEARN Program held?

Monday, June 5th through Friday, July 28. No program Tuesday, July 4th.

What are the program hours?

Program operates from 7 AM until 6 PM.

What grades can attend?

This summer, we will be serving children 1st-6th grade (fall 2023).

Where will the program be held?

This summer, we will be at New Haven United Methodist Church (630 Lincoln Hwy. E., New Haven) for grades 1st-4th grade. Students in 5th-6th grade will be at the Powerhouse Youth Center (830 Main St., New Haven). Parents with children in both grade sets may drop off at NHUMC and LEARN will transport 5th and 6th graders to the Powerhouse at approximately 8:30 AM. Any 5th-6th grader being dropped off after 8:30 will need to be dropped off at the Powerhouse.

How much does the program cost?

LEARN charges a non-refundable \$35/child registration fee.

Full-time weekly rate is \$145 for 1 child and \$225 for 2 children. LEARN is not offering part-time enrollments. Weekly program fees are based on a full week and is due regardless of your child's attendance. Credits are not available for absences.

When are payments due?

Registration fees are due at time of registration. Weekly program fees are due no later than the close of program on Friday for the upcoming week and is due regardless of your child's attendance.

What happens if I pay after Friday?

If payment is not received by the close of program on Friday, you will be charged a \$20 late fee.

Do I have to pay the weekly fee if my family takes a vacation?

Parents enrolling their child(ren) in Summer LEARN will be allotted one-week vacation (five consecutive days) in which that week's fee will be waived when providing LEARN a 2-week advance notice. If your vacation is part of one week and part of the next, payment for both weeks will be due in full. Program fees for the remaining seven (7) weeks of program are due in full.

What kinds of activities will Summer LEARN offer?

During the morning hours, your child will participate in academic enrichment activities in math, science, and literacy. In the afternoon, children will participate in activities on each week's theme. Most weeks, we will offer field trips. Breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack will be provided each day.
